The First SARC International Conference on Japan-South Asia Connections on Economy, Health and Education

to be held online from Soka University Japan on October 30-31, 2020

The COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted the global world order created after World War II. The pandemic has undermined the quality of life and compromised work across countries. For private enterprises it has reduced their earnings drastically. New ways of conducting business, improving health, creating new education should be found. We need ingenuity to create new strategies in regional economy and health. We need to find new connections between global trade and digital technology, economy and innovation, skill creation and labor movement and village craft and design. Our old business supply routes are moving from traditional face-to-face to online. All markets in the region especially automobile, medical supply and movement of medical professionals must be overhauled. We need to remap and make sustainable entertainment, hoteling, restaurant and café business. There is a need to find new ways to sustain the GIG economy, supply value chains, rule-based global trade and global trade regime. The reform of WTO in a manner that unilateralism, protectionism, and populism does not affect its global outreach. There is a need to empower global health systems, coproduce drugs and vaccines, and provide psychological health care. Finally, the entire education system has gone online creating new hybrid classes. Just as the global middle class has shrunk so have the international students. What is the future direction of global schools and higher education we have to envision?

The two-days conference aims to bring together experts in the field of economics, health, education, regional development, traditional craft, modern design and architecture from Japan, South Asia and the rest of the world. The South Asian region is becoming a source of abundant manpower and professional expertise which different partnerships can exploit. Changes in regional trade and health in the last few months have realigned connections in the region. The conference will address some of these issues and provide solutions wherever possible.

This conference will be held in English. However, we will welcome presentations in Japanese.
