

Details of Pioneer Hall

Pioneer Hall is open to successful candidates and degree-seeking MALE students enrolled in postgraduate program. This off-campus dormitory was built in April 1997 to provide a place for interaction and to support research's life of the students.

(1) Location

SOKA University Pioneer Hall, 358-1 Sanyu-cho, Hachioji-shi, Tokyo, 192-0012, Japan

*Walk around 20 minutes from university's main gate.

(2) Eligibility

- Current graduate school students or the successful candidates enrolled in postgraduate program.
- Those who able to make the dormitory payment in a lump-sum or installments for semesters.

(3) Period to stay

>Basically 1 year. For the students who under enrollment period are available to apply for continuation.

>For those who do not apply for continuation after one-year stay may order to moving out from dormitory.

(4) Moving-out

Please submit Residence Status Form by end of December.

Check-out date is by end of March. Details to be confirmed.

(5) Dormitory Fees for AY2022

- **Occupancy Fee: 50,000 JPY**
- **Rental Fee: 225,500 JPY/semester**

*Utility expenses are included.

*Occupancy Fee is required to pay only once upon entering the dormitory.

(6) Details of Pioneer Hall

- Total 46 rooms
- One room with 6 tatami (area 10m²)
- Facilities

< Room >

Flooring with carpet, air conditioner (with heater function), single bed, table, chair, closet, wi-fi available.

< Shared Space >

Kitchen space, refrigerator, laundry facilities, washbasins and toilets, lounge, bathroom (ofuro), and bicycle.
