It is not easy to get diamonds. There are diamonds in Africa, Australia, Russia, and Canada. In most of these places, they are deep underground\*. People have to dig far down to get them. In South Africa, for example, diamonds are sometimes found more than 3,000 feet (1,000 meters) underground. In other places, diamonds are on the ground or in rivers. But they are 16 to find. Very few people find big diamonds and become rich.

Why are diamonds so expensive? First of all, they are very beautiful. In the past, kings and queens wanted to wear diamonds. Today, famous people like to wear them. A diamond on your finger shows that you are 17 and rich. Diamonds also have other meanings. In the United States and in India, for example, they mean love. They are something special that you give to someone special. 18, diamonds are very useful because they are very hard. People can use them to cut metal and other stones.

The high price of diamonds leads some people to do 19 things to get them. People fight wars and kill each other over diamonds. This happened in the past in India. These days it is still happening in Africa. The civil wars\*\* in Sierra Leone\*\*\* and the Congo\*\*\*\* happened partly because of diamonds. In those wars, both 20 got money from diamonds. They used the money to buy guns, pay soldiers, and keep fighting. Because of diamond money, many people lost their homes and life.

"What can I do in New York?" It depends on how much time and money you have! No matter how long you are in New York, you can never see and do everything. There are more than 200 museums in New York City. Some of the most famous ones are the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Museum of Modern Art and the Natural History Museum. New York is also the home of Broadway, the theater district, where there are hundreds of large theaters with 38 for every interest. It's the home of Lincoln Center, where you can see operas and ballets and listen to all kinds of music. If you like sports, you can see professional baseball, basketball, ice hockey, tennis and so on.

New York is truly a city of immigrants, and they bring their languages, traditions and customs with them. In less than one hour, you can walk from Chinatown to Little Italy and Orchard Street which is a street full of Jewish shops on the Lower East Side. You can continue on to East Sixth Street, a street full of Indian shops and restaurants. 40 spending a penny or taking a ship or plane, you can enjoy one culture to another completely different one in just minutes. This is just one of many interesting and unusual things that people like about New York.

Why do so many immigrants come here? Two important reasons are economic and educational opportunities. They want to get good jobs, so they can make a better 42 for themselves and their children. They also come to New York for educational opportunities. In addition to the elementary schools and high schools, there are many colleges and universities in New York. Immigrants can study English along with other subjects, and they can often get 43 aid from the government to help them pay for their education. New York is truly a city of opportunity.
