What is a glacier? Any large mass of snow and ice on land, which lasts for many years, may be called a glacier. Glaciers are made when more snow 26 than melts over a number of years. As the snow is pressed down, it changes into solid ice. Eventually, this mass of snow and ice gets very heavy. When this happens it starts to move. If the glacier forms on a slope, it moves down. However, if the glacier is on a 27 area, it moves out in all directions.

Most people have never seen a glacier. Most would say that very few exist. Some people think glaciers are 28 only in faraway mountains. Are they really so rare? Think about these facts.

About three-fourths of all the 29 in the world is stored as glacier ice. This is about the same as 60 years of rainfall all over the globe. In North America, there is more water stored as snow and ice in glaciers than in all the lakes, ponds, and rivers.

Where can you go to find the best glaciers? To see them, you should 30 to Alaska. Air routes fly over or very near some of the largest glaciers in North America.
