Eleanor Roosevelt was born in New York City on October 11, 1834. Her parents, Elliot and Anna, were very wealthy. They had many servants, a home in the city, and a large summer house in the country. However, when Eleanor was just eight years old, her mother died. She went to live with her grandmother and was raised strictly. Two years later, 41 . Having lost both of her parents, she missed them terribly and dreamed of them often. She was very unhappy in her childhood.

At the age of fifteen, Eleanor was sent to Allenswood, a famous school in London. She was excited to go there and felt that she was starting a new life. With the encouragement of the head teacher, Mrs. Marie Souvestre, the shy girl emerged as an active school leader. After graduation, she returned to New York. She started working as a social worker for the poor people in the city.

On March 17, 1905, she married her distant cousin Franklin D. Roosevelt. In the next eleven years, Eleanor gave birth to one daughter and five sons. After her husband was elected as the senator of New York in 1910, she took a positive role as a wife of a public official. However, in 1921, Franklin suddenly came down with polio*. He could not walk on his own because of the disease. Eleanor practically became a nurse for him and took good care of him. She attended political meetings for her husband and brought back detailed reports on what she heard or saw there. She also traveled with Franklin to political meetings.

Franklin became the President of the United States in 1932 and was reelected in 1936, 1940, and 1944. The 1930s was a hard time because of the Great Depression**. Almost all banks and factories closed, and millions of people lost their jobs. The economy was dead, and hungry people stood in long lines for free bread and soup everywhere. It was a very difficult time for the American President and the First Lady. But, Eleanor was never discouraged.

Eleanor always said that "Tomorrow is now!" She had a regular radio program and also wrote daily newspaper columns to encourage people. She traveled to cities, towns, farms, and coal mines to meet people. She brought hope to millions of American people.

President Franklin D. Roosevelt died on April 12, 1945. The whole country expressed great sadness. Eleanor left the White House. She was not a wife of a politician any more, but she did not retire from public life. "Life is meant to be lived," she said. A few months after World War II ended, Eleanor started working for world peace. She was appointed as the U.S. representative at the United Nations, where leaders from all over the world could meet and discuss their differences. Eleanor said, "If we are to live together, we have to talk." Eleanor died on November 7, 1962 when she was seventy-seven years old. President Harry S. Truman called her "First Lady of the World," and said that she was the most important and most loved woman of her time.
